

FLOOR TILES



Got fabric squares? Use them on these easy to make floor tiles. Make one or several!

Use them anywhere you'd like to add color or protect your flooring.

While the floor tiles in the pattern are based on 6" fabric squares, use the techniques to make floor tiles with any size fabric squares.

MATERIALS

FABRIC

6" fabric squares

Sashing, Binding

1 TILE

9

¼ yard

6 TILES

54

1½ yards

Note on sashing: While a high contrast sashing has a dramatic look, if you are sewing many tiles together consider more coordinated print for your sashing (see front cover). A print will be more forgiving if your sashing doesn't line up perfectly!

Backing fabric

½ yard

1½ yards

IN-R-FORM PLUS**

½ yard

1 yard

Use In-R-Form Plus by Bosal, a double-sided fusible foam batting OR if you have sew-in foam batting (which is slightly thicker than the fusible) fuse Splendid Web by Bosal or Wonder Under by Pellon to each side to make it a double-sided fusible foam

FUSIBLE WEB TAPE

2 yards

12 yards

Use ½" wide Steam-A-Seam2 Lite or Splendid Tape by Bosal. Both are on release paper.

MATCHING COTTON THREAD use a 50 weight piecing thread.

If using different fabrics for sashing/binding and backing, use thread that matches your sashing/binding on top and use thread that matches your backing in the bobbin.

Other Tools: Sewing Machine with a walking foot (an open toe walking foot is ideal), Parchment paper or Teflon ironing sheet. Scissors (both large and small), rotary mat, 60mm rotary cutter, acrylic rulers, chalk, seam ripper, measuring tape.

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
