BALI BOWLS BASIC BOWL, CATNAP BOWL, BUSHEL BASKET

Materials

FABRIC

Buy good quality cotton; does not have to be washed. Fabric can be cut on the bias or with the grain. Use 2 ½" strips cut the full width of the fabric, generally 42". Make sure you have a few extra strips. Avoid flannel or heavier fabric. Batiks and jellyrolls work beautifully. Please note, if using leftover binding, 2 ¼" widths will still work with the clothesline method ONLY. You will need to pull a little tighter when sewing to the clothesline. For a watercolor or BALI look, use a different shade of batik fabric for each strip or use Hoffman CA Fabrics' Bali Pops™ – which contain 40 individual batik strips.

CLOTHESLINE

Cotton clothesline that is 3/16'' to 7/32'' in diameter. It can have a non-cotton (synthetic) core as long as it is soft and flexible - soft enough to sew. Do not use poly clothesline.

DOUBLE-SIDED FUSIBLE BATTING Use a beefy double-sided fusible batting.

Try Bosal's **Duet Fuse II**, now available in one yard packages and pre-cut rolls $2^{1}/4'' \times 20$ yards, enough for 16 fabric strips.

Clothesline Version

Basic Bowl (8 1/2" wide x 3" deep)

Fabric: 11 - 2 ½" x 42" fabric strips (1 yard) 10 for the bowl, 1 for the binding Other: Clothesline: 35 feet

Bushel Basket (12" wide x 10" deep)

Fabric: $29 - 2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 42''$ fabric strips (2 yards)
28 for the bowl, 1 for the binding
Other:Other:Clothesline: 100 feet

Catnap Bowl (14" wide x 6" deep)

Fabric: $21 - 2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 42''$ fabric strips ($1\frac{3}{4}$ yards)
20 for the bowl, 1 for the binding
Other:Other:Clothesline: 75 feet

Double-sided Fusible Batting Version

8 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" fabric strips (¾ yard) One 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strip for the binding Double-sided fusible batting: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard Cut 8 strips 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 45"

21 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" fabric strips (1³/₄ yards) One 3¹/₂" x 42" strip for the binding Double-sided fusible batting: 1¹/₂ yards Cut 21 strips 2¹/₄" x 45"

16 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" fabric strips (1¹/₄ yards) One 3¹/₂" x 42" strip for the binding Double-sided fusible batting: 1 yard Cut 16 strips 2¹/₄" x 45"

Matching cotton thread

This project uses a lot of thread. Before beginning, pre-fill at least 2 bobbins. A 50-weight 2-ply thread is perfect for this project.

Embellishments

Seed beads for the Catnap Bowl OR 8 buttons (or more to nest) for the Bushel Basket

Other Tools: Sewing Machine with a good zigzag stitch, Machine needles: Microtex 90/14 for straight stitching and Denim 110/18 for zigzag stitching. An extension table is helpful for flat bowl bottoms.
