A NEW TAKE ON A TUFFET



Little Miss Muffet rested her feet on this tuffet and let all of her cares float away!

Use 2 ½" strips of fabric and batting or pre-quilted fabric to make these lovely hassocks. Bows on each side double as handles.

Large is 18" wide x 15" high Small is 14" wide x 12" high

MATERIALS: Use good quality cotton fabric. Hoffman CA Fabrics Bali Pops™ and jelly rolls are wonderful for this project. Try Hoffman's new 1895 Bali Pops!!

<u>FABRIC</u>		<u>Large</u>	<u>Small</u>
Sides, Top and Bottom	2 ½" x 42/44" strips	80	40
Binding, Handles (Bows)		1¼ yds	1 yd

BATTING (*medium weight batting 45" wide*) 6 yds 3 yds
Use up your leftover batting or cut a queen size batting into 2½" strips

MATCHING COTTON THREAD Use a 50-weight 2-ply thread.

This project uses a lot of thread. Before beginning, prefill 4 bobbins.

Note: Instead of 2½" strips and batting use single or double-sided pre-quilted fabric 1 yard (small) or 1½ yards (large) plus binding and handle fabric listed above. Instructions are on pgs 9-12 (fill only one bobbin)

FOAM INSERT

Firm Foam Hassock from Bosal Foam and Fiber Large - 18"w x 15"h (Bosal Item #1815) Small - 14"w x 12"h (Bosal Item #1412)

Available in quilt shops or online at wingspancrafts.com

Other Tools: Sewing Machine with a good zigzag stitch, sewing machine needles Microtex 90/14 (for straight stitching) and Jean's or Denim 110/18 (for zigzag stitching). Scissors (both large and small), rotary mat, 60mm rotary cutter, acrylic rulers, chalk, seam ripper, Milliners needles size 8, heavy thread or perl cotton, measuring tape. Design or foam core board.
