



HAT BOXES

Fanciful storage.
Either round or square!



MATERIALS

FABRIC (WOF = width of fabric usually 42/44")

	Medium (10" x 6") Round or Square	Large (12" x 8") Round or Square
<i>Box Sides</i>	1¼ yard or 17 strips 2½" x WOF	1½ yards or 21 strips 2½" x WOF
<i>Binding</i>	¾ yard	¾ yard
<i>Top and Bottom</i>	¾ yard (4-11" squares)	¾ yard (4-13" squares)
<i>Optional Bow:</i>	¼ yard (2 strips 3" x WOF)	

SIDE INTERFACING 1 yard 1 yard

Use *IN-R-FORM Single-Sided Fusible Foam Stabilizer 58" wide (#495S)* by BOSAL available at quilt shops or online at wingspancrafts.com

TOP AND BOTTOM INTERFACING

Use *CRAF-TEX PLUS Double Sided Fusible Stiff Interfacing* by BOSAL
1¼ yards 1½ yards

MATCHING COTTON THREAD- use a 50 weight 2 ply thread. Also, for hand sewing, use a heavy cotton thread like Aurifil's 12 weight cotton

Other Tools: Sewing Machine with a good zigzag stitch, machine needles- Microtex 90/14 (for straight stitching) and Jean's or Denim 110/18 (for zigzag stitching). Try Inspira brand needles for best results. Protractor or other circle drawing tool or try Creative Grids Circle Drawing ruler. Parchment paper or Teflon ironing sheet. Scissors (both large and small), rotary mat, 60mm rotary cutter, acrylic rulers, chalk, seam ripper, measuring tape, and hand sewing needles - try Milliner's needles size 8.

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
