

# DOUBLE DIP Place Mats

Great quilt as you go technique.  
You will be doing double flips as you learn  
how easy these reversible placemats are to make.  
One jelly roll or Bali Pop, plus a few extra strips,  
will make six place mats!

*Samples on the front cover were made from  
Hoffman Fabrics 1895 Bali Pops™*

Placemats are approximately 14" x 19"

## MATERIALS

**FABRIC** (WOF = width of fabric usually 42/44")

For a scrappy look, use a different fabric for each strip!

	<b>1 Place Mat</b>	<b>6 Place Mats</b>
<i>STYLE A Body</i>		
Two fabrics	¼ yard each	1½ yards each
Fabric Strips (2½" x WOF)	7 strips (or more)	40 strips
<i>STYLE B Body</i>		
Two fabrics	½ yard each	1¾ yards each
Fabric Strips (2½" x WOF)	8 strips (or more)	48 strips
<i>BINDING both styles</i>	¼ yard	1 yard
<b><u>INTERFACING</u></b>	1 yard (makes 6 place mats)	
<i>Use IN-R-FORM PLUS by Bosal</i>		

**MATCHING COTTON THREAD** use a good piecing thread

**Other Tools:** Sewing Machine with a walking foot, machine needles-  
Microtex 90/14. Parchment paper or Teflon ironing sheet. Scissors (both  
large and small), rotary mat, rotary cutter, acrylic rulers, chalk, and  
maybe a seam ripper!!
