Materials

FABRIC Use one or two fabrics or many!! Hoffman CA Fabrics Bali Pops ™ are wonderful for this project.

Large Basket: Basket 3 yards or 40 strips 2½" x 42/44"

Handles & Binding: ½ yard

Small Basket: Basket 1½ yards or 20 strips 2½" x 42/44"

Handles & Binding: ½ yard

Optional Lining: 2 yards for the small or large

Ribbon for the tie

DUO-FUSE Large 2¼ yards Small 1¼ yards

by Innovative Craft Products is a beefy double-sided fusible batting available in 45" x 36" packages.

Alternate interfacing: Fusible Thermolam (TP971F) by Pellon - double the amount listed above as two strips of Thermolam are needed for each strip of Duo-Fuse

MATCHING COTTON THREAD- use a 50 weight 2 ply thread

ADDITIONALLY FOR THE HANDLES (for one basket)

Plastic Plumbing Tubing (.170 ¼" Polyethylene) 3 feet Stiff Interfacing 2 strips 1¾" wide x 18" long

Use Rigid Weave, Craf-tex, Peltex, or Timtex

(or you can purchase Aunties Two Happy Handles Kit #AT238 which contains both the tubing and strips of stiff interfacing pre-cut to $1\frac{3}{4}$ " wide)

Other Tools: Sewing Machine with a good zigzag stitch, machine needles- Microtex 90/14 (for straight stitching) and Jean's or Denim 110/18 (for zigzag stitching). Parchment paper (can be found in grocery stores) 4 feet or a Teflon pressing sheet. Scissors (both large and small), rotary mat , 60mm rotary cutter, acrylic rulers, chalk, seam ripper, measuring tape.
