


# Woven Spirals



Fun to make!



**Unique decorative bowl  
With a unique 12 pointed star on the  
inside and outside bottom!**

## FABRIC

Fabric A

½ yard or 2 fat quarters

Fabric B

½ yard or 2 fat quarters

Use b to limit fraying

## INTERFACING

Stiff double-sided fusible interfacing\* 20" wide

1 yard

*\*We recommend Crafter-Tex Plus, Peltex 72F or Fast 2 Fuse Heavyweight*

## COORDINATED THREAD

For machine sewing, use a 50 weight thread. For basting the top together, use a heavier 12 weight cotton matching your sewing thread.

## EMBELLISHMENTS

Twelve small buttons or more if you want to layer your buttons. Or try ribbon or home dec cording.

## OPTIONS

Make these bowls from cork (two 18" squares) or thick felted wool (one 18" square of thick 3MM felt; one 18" square of 1.2MM thick felt). No need to zigzag stitch the edges.



## Other Tools:

Parchment paper or Teflon ironing sheet. Sewing machine, Microtex 90/14 machine needles, very sharp scissors (both large and small), template plastic, Clover Wonder Clips, pins, Milliner's needles size 5 (hand sewing), rubber needle puller, Fray Check, rotary mat, acrylic rulers, rotary cutter, chalk or other marking tool, steam iron.
