



Hot Pockets

Simply sewn, thermal pockets
Make a casserole carrier or a pizza pouch

Pattern includes instructions for pockets
made with one main fabric OR
a quilt as you go version using $2\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric
strips (casserole carrier only)

Casserole Carrier is 13" x 18", fits a 9" x 13" casserole

Small Pizza Pouch is 14" x 14", fits a 12" pizza

Large Pizza Pouch is 18" x 18", fits a 16" pizza

MATERIALS

Small Pizza Pouch

Large Pizza Pouch

Casserole Carrier

Single Main Fabric

1½ yards

1¾ yards

1½ yards

Use a novelty pizza print, school colors or your favorite batiks!!

OR

Quilt as you Go Casserole Carrier Using $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Strips (page 7 & 8)

Lining Fabric

1 yard

Fabric Strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42/44"

14 strips

ALSO (for either version) you will need:

Binding and Handles (all sizes)

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard cotton fabric

Interfacing - Thermal Batting (all sizes)

1 yard

Use Bosal's Poly-Therm Fleece (62" wide) or if using Warm & Company's Insul-Bright double the amount above as it is NOT as wide as Bosal's batting. Zigzag stitch Insul-Bright together to get the required length.

Optional: Decorative Buttons

Other Supplies and Tools: Sewing machine with a free arm. Thread.

Iron, scissors, pins, rotary mat, rotary cutter,
acrylic rulers, chalk, seam ripper, hand sewing
needles.
