DOUBLE-SIDED FUSIBLE BATTING 45" wide 4½ yards We recommend Duet Fuse II by Bosal

FOAM CHAIR by **Bosal** Item #BC101

Order through your quilt shop or online through wingspancrafts.com

COORDINATING THREAD for your machine and a heavy thread (size 12 cotton) for hand sewing the sides to the body.

BUTTONS Four large buttons to secure the tops of the side pockets

OPTIONAL PILLOW:

For the front of the pillow, use leftover fabric from the sides and body

For the Back, Binding and Sashing 1 yard Pillow Stuffing or Pillow Form 12" x 16"

<u>Other Tools:</u> Large piece (45" x 54") of kraft or white paper to trace side of chair, sewing machine, Microtex 90/14 machine needles, very sharp scissors (both large and small), rotary mat, acrylic rulers, rotary cutter, chalk or other marking tool, size 5 milliner's needle
