



MINI BAGS

Irresistible mini bags for little things.
Great for giving gift cards, cash, candy
or other treasures!

Cute, for a little girl's first purse.

Makes unique Christmas ornaments!!

Easy to make in 3 styles.

Open Tote (4" wide x 3½" tall x 2" deep),

Hobo (4" wide x 4" tall x 2" deep)

Crossbody (4" wide x 4" tall)

MATERIALS

FABRIC (for each Mini Bag)

Fabric A Bag Body One Fat Quarter
Not suited for directional prints

Fabric B Binding, Handles and Bottom One Fat Quarter

DOUBLE-SIDED FUSIBLE BATTING ¼ yard will make all 3

Use Bosal's DUET FUSE II

STIFF DOUBLE-SIDED FUSIBLE INTERFACING

Use Pellon's 72F - two 3" x 5" rectangles for the Open Tote only!

Note: To turn your own batting or stiff interfacing into double-sided fusible, fuse Bosal's Splendid Web on Release Paper (or it's equivalent like Pellon's Wonder Under) to both sides. Remove the paper before fusing to fabric.

BUTTONS

Open Tote 1 medium and 1 small
Hobo 2 small
Crossbody Bag 2 medium, 2 small and 2 sew-on magnetic
(we recommend Bohin sew-on magnetic buttons)

MATCHING COTTON THREAD

Piecing thread to match Fabric A and B

Other Tools: Sewing Machine. Iron. Parchment paper or Teflon sheet. Frixion pen or chalk. Scissors (both large and small), pins, Clover Wonder Clips, Turn It All tool, template plastic, rotary mat, rotary cutter, acrylic rulers, seam ripper, measuring tape, hand sewing needles milliner's Size 7

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
