

FUSED AND FOLDED BOXES

Fuse fabric to stiff interfacing, cut, bind and fold to create practical storage boxes. Pattern includes instructions for a 6" x 6" x 10" box and a 4" x 10" x 11" magazine holder.

Great for all those quilting patterns and magazines!

MATERIALS

Fabric (must be 44" wide)

Buy good quality cotton; does not have to be washed

Hoffman CA Fabrics' batiks and screen prints are fabulous for this project

Inn-Spire Plus a double-sided fusible stiff interfacing - 20" wide

or use a stiff interfacing and enough fusible web to cover both sides

While other interfacings will do, use Inn-Spire Plus for best results

Buttons for closure - 8 for the box (4 outside/4 inside)
6 for the magazine holder (3 outside/3 inside)

Use dramatic buttons on the outside and small flat buttons on the inside
(*Note: Long prong brads (1") can be used instead of buttons - see last page of pattern. These are generally available in gold or silver at office supply stores. 4 brads for the box; 3 brads for the magazine holder*)

Other Tools: Matching machine thread for all fabrics, sewing machine, Microtex sewing machine needles (90/14), scissors (both large and small), Perl cotton or other heavy thread for attaching buttons, pins, rotary mat and cutter, acrylic rulers, awl, seam ripper, chalk or other temporary marking tool (two colors) and measuring tape
