

CRISSCROSS

RUG, TABLE RUNNER, PLACE MAT, MUG RUG OR TABLE PAD
Simply woven, four practical items for your home.

FABRIC Cut 2½" fabric strips the full width of cotton quilting fabric, generally 42/44" wide. After sewing, strips are cut to the appropriate lengths, either short or long, before weaving. Select contrasting fabrics for long and short strips. Use pre-cut Bali Pops or Jelly Rolls or yardage listed below. (Note: If you want to use scraps see directions for each project.)

FUSIBLE INTERFACING 45" wide

Use a thin single-sided fusible interfacing. We recommend Pellon's 987F Fusible Fleece or Bosal's 326LF

RUG (38" x 20")

Long strips: 1¾ yards cut into 23 strips 2½" x 42/44" (or select 23 pre-cut strips)
Short strips: 1¾ yards cut into 23 strips 2½" x 42/44" (or select 23 pre-cut strips)
Binding: ¼ yard cut into 3 strips 2½" x 42/44"
Interfacing: 2½ yards cut into 46 strips 1¾" x 45"

Note: Rug takes 46 fabric strips. If using a Bali Pop™ or jelly roll (40 strips) purchase extra binding material to cut the additional 6 strips needed

TABLE RUNNER (38" x 13")

Long strips: 1¼ yards cut into 15 strips 2½" x 42/44" (or select 15 pre-cut strips)
Short strips: 1¼ yards cut into 15 strips 2½" x 42/44" (or select 15 pre-cut strips)
Binding: ¼ yard cut into 3 strips 2½" x 42/44"
Interfacing: 1½ yards cut into 30 strips 1¾" x 45"

PLACE MAT (18" x 13")

Long strips: ¾ yard cut into 8 strips 2½" x 42/44" (or select 8 pre-cut strips)
Short strips: ½ yard cut into 7 strips 2½" x 42/44" (or select 7 pre-cut strips)
Binding: ¼ yard cut into 2 strips 2½" x 42/44"
Interfacing: ¾ yard cut into 15 strips 1¾" x 45"

MUG RUG OR TABLE PAD (9½" x 7½")

Long strips: ¼ yard cut into 3 strips 2½" x 42/44" (or select 3 pre-cut strips)
Short strips: ¼ yard cut into 3 strips 2½" x 42/44" (or select 3 pre-cut strips)
Binding: ⅛ yard cut into 1 strip 2½" x 42/44"
Interfacing: ½ yard cut into 6 strips 1¾" x 45"

Other Supplies and Tools: Matching or coordinating cotton thread, sewing machine, sewing machine needles - Microtex 90/14. Iron, Dritz Thermal Thimbles, scissors (both large and small), red Clover Wonder Clips or pins, rotary mat, rotary cutter, acrylic rulers, chalk, seam ripper, hand sewing needles.
