

DIAGONALLY WOVEN BASKETS



Fill them with candy,
fill them with shells,
use one on your desk for
mail and cards

5" wide x 9" long x 6" tall

FABRIC

Weaving Strips

Cut 2½" fabric strips the full width of cotton fabric, generally 42/44" wide. After sewing, cut left and right slanting strips to length on a 45 degree angle. Consider using contrasting fabrics for the right and left strips. Or make it scrappy!

2½" x WOF strips

5 strips for the right slanting strips
5 strips for the left slanting strips

Bottom & Binding

¾ yd

INTERFACING

For weaving

¾ yd

Use Single-Sided Light Fusible (WS426) by Bosal or Fusible Fleece (987F) by Pellon

For the bottom

½ yd

Use a double-sided stiff interfacing like Craf-tex Plus by Bosal or Peltex II by Pellon

EMBELLISHMENTS

Buttons or Hot Fix Crystals

Other Supplies and Tools: Matching or coordinating cotton thread. Sewing machine with a free arm. Iron, Dritz Thermal Thimbles, scissors (both large and small), red Clover Wonder Clips or pins, rotary mat, rotary cutter, a 6" x 12" acrylic ruler and other acrylic rulers, chalk, seam ripper, hand sewing needles.

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
