# Woven Hexi Flower Bowls

## Fun to make! Cute decorative little bowls. Great for desk, sewing table, drawer storage and organization

Large Small (5" wide x  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " tall) (4" wide x  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " tall)

**FABRIC** *Use batiks to limit fraying* 

Fabric A 1 fat quarter\* 1 fat quarter Fabric B 1 fat quarter\* 1 fat quarter

### **INTERFACING**

Stiff double-sided fusible interfacing\* 20" wide - 34 yard will make both

1 yard is enough to make 1 large and 2 small

\*We recommend Craf-Tex Plus, Peltex 72F or Fast 2 Fuse Heavyweight

#### **COORDINATED THREAD**

For machine sewing, use a 50 weight thread. For sewing buttons, use a heavier 12 weight cotton matching your sewing thread. Look for Sulky or Aurifil 12 weight cotton thread.

#### **EMBELLISHMENTS**

Six 1" buttons.

If you want to layer your buttons, six 1" buttons and six  $\frac{1}{2}$ " buttons.

#### **Other Tools:**

Parchment paper or Teflon ironing sheet. Sewing machine, Microtex 90/14 machine needles, very sharp scissors (try Karen Kay Buckley Perfect Scissors medium or large), freezer paper, Clover Wonder Clips regular and jumbo, pins, Milliner's needles size 5 (hand sewing), rubber needle puller or grabber, Fray Check, rotary mat, acrylic rulers, rotary cutter, chalk or Frixion pen, steam iron.

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<sup>\*</sup> for the large bowl, fat quarters must be 22" x 18"
