



# LITTLE POPPINS BAGS

Zipper top bag in two sizes. Lots of pockets on the inside keep everything organized. Structural stays keep it in shape.

*Larger: 13" wide x 12" tall x 9" deep,  
Smaller: 13" wide x 9" tall x 9" deep*

*Directions given are for non-directional print fabric.  
Fabric with a directional print may require more fabric (see below).*

## MATERIALS

### FABRIC

#### **FABRIC A Outside**

Bag Body, Sashing

Larger

½ yard

Smaller

⅔ yard

*Note: If using directional print fabric, you will need enough fabric to cut the following*

Bag Body, Sashing, Pockets

Handles, Bottom, Binding, Bows, Tabs

### INTERFACING

Bag Body: Bosal's IN-R-FORM PLUS (58" wide) 1 yard for either size

Bottoms: Stiff double-sided fusible interfacing (20" wide)

Bosal's CRAF-TEX PLUS or Pellon's 72F ½ yard either size

*Or use pre-cut Craftertex Plus Small Camden Bag Bottoms by Bosal.*

### STAYS:

2 Stays included with the pattern. Use two stays per bag. Stays also sold separately.

¼" PLUMBING TUBING (for handles): 5 feet available at hardware stores

### ZIPPER:

24" Handbag Zipper with Double Slides (opens on both ends)

### MATCHING COTTON THREAD

Piecing thread to match all fabrics AND 12 weight cotton thread, by Aurifil or Sulky, matching FABRIC C for hand sewing

**Other Tools:** Sewing Machine, walking foot, sewing machine needles Microtex 90/14. Steam iron. Parchment paper or Teflon sheet. Creative Grids "Quick Trim and Circle" ruler. Scissors (both large and small), pins, Clover Wonder clips, paper, rotary mat, 60mm rotary cutter, acrylic rulers, chalk or Frixion pen, seam ripper, Milliner's size 5 hand sewing needles, measuring tape.

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
