



# Woven Vase

Fun to make!  
Cute decorative containers.  
Great for plants, kitchen  
utensils, desk and  
bathroom. Make from  
fabric or cork fabric



## MATERIALS

### FABRIC VASE

	Large	Medium
FABRIC A	5/8 yard	1/2 yard
FABRIC B	5/8 yard	1/2 yard

Use batiks!!! to lessen fraying

### INTERFACING *Craf-Tex Plus by Bosal*

Stiff double-sided fusible interfacing 20" wide - 1 yard for either size

### CORK VASE

For cork, we recommend making the medium vase only

CORK FABRIC A	NA	18" x 33"
CORK FABRIC B	NA	18" x 33"

### INTERFACING *Splendid Web Plus on Release Paper (Item 445-1) by Bosal*

Fusible web on Release paper 20" wide 1 yard

### FOR BOTH FABRIC AND CORK

**COORDINATED THREAD** For machine sewing, use a 50 weight thread or, for stitching that really pops, use 28 weight or 12 weight (by Aurifil or Sulky). For sewing on buttons, use 12 weight thread

### EMBELLISHMENTS

Six 1" buttons for the outside and six buttons for for the inside.  
To layer your buttons on the outside, six 1" buttons and six 1/2" buttons

### Other Tools:

Parchment paper or Teflon ironing sheet. Sewing machine, Microtex 90/14 machine needles, very sharp scissors (try Karen Kay Buckley Perfect Scissors medium or large), freezer paper, Jumbo Clover Wonder Clips, flower head pins, Milliner's needles size 5 (hand sewing), rubber needle puller or grabber, Fray Check, rotary mat, acrylic rulers, rotary cutter, chalk or Frifixion pen, steam iron.

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
