

SEBAGO TOTE

Quick over the shoulder bag. Fun technique.
Updated to include two sizes.
Great for shopping at quilt shows!! Quick and practical gift!

MATERIALS

DOUBLE SIDED PRE-QUILTED FABRIC: 1 yard 42/44" wide
(Do not use prints that are one directional)

One yard makes: One Large bag (13" tall x 19" wide x 5" deep)
 Two Small bags (9" tall x 13" wide x 4" deep)

Note: the print on the lower half of the bag (outside pockets) will be the same as the print on the inside of the bag (SIDE A). The other side only shows at the top of the bag (SIDE B)

*If you cannot find a double-sided pre-quilted fabric that you like, quilt your own
OR*

*Fuse fabric to both sides of a double-sided fusible batting like
Duet Fuse II by Bosal or Warm Fleece 2 by Warm and Company.*

Quilt your fused fabric, if desired.

To quilt or fuse your own fabric, you will need:

*1 yard each of two fabrics (42/44" wide) and
1 yard of cotton batting or double-sided fusible batting (36" x 45")*

BINDING

Two strips 2½" by 42/44" for EACH bag.

MATCHING COTTON THREAD

For both the bag and the binding (if a different color)

Other Tools:

Sewing machine with a free arm. Rotary cutter, mat, rulers, scissors, pins, measuring tape. A turning tool to turn the handles right side out. We recommend a Turn It All by Specialty Distributors or Quick Turn by Dritz. Marking tools like chalk or a pen.
