Bag Body: Bosal's IN-R-FORM PLUS (#493-58) 54" x 58"wide IN-R-FORM PLUS is a double-sided fusible foam batting

Inside Bottom: Bosal's CRAF-TEX PLUS (20" wide) ½ yard CRAF-TEX PLUS is a double-sided fusible stiff interfacing

ZIPPER 30" Handbag Zipper with a wide zipper tape and double slides Available at many local quilt shops or online from wingspancrafts.com

STAYS also sold separately - use AT627 Poppins Bag Stays (Size B)

Other Tools: Thread to match fabric. Sewing machine with a walking foot and free arm, sewing machine needles Microtex 90/14 or Janome Purple Tip needles. Steam iron. DM Quilting Basic Marker Tools 12" x 12" Basic Marker (available through DMQuilting.com)
