

COVERED OVAL CRATES

Practical storage in beautiful covered oval boxes

Small 12" wide, 8" deep, 8" tall

Medium 15" wide, 10" deep, 10" tall

Large 18" wide, 12" deep, 12" tall

FABRIC (42/44" wide)

FOR INDIVIDUAL SIZES

Use one **FOCUS FABRIC (Outside and Inside)**
and one **COORDINATING FABRIC**

<i>FOCUS FABRIC (Outside, Inside)</i>	<u>Small</u>	<u>Medium</u>	<u>Large</u>
Sides and Rim	1 yard	1¼ yards	1½ yards
<i>COORDINATING FABRIC</i>			
Binding, Top, Bottom	1 yard	1⅜ yards	1⅞ yards

USING DIRECTIONAL FABRIC may require more fabric.

*Look at Cutting Instructions on page 1 and page 2
to make sure you have enough*

FOR A SET OF THREE

(one of each size) Use one **FOCUS FABRIC (Outside)** like Hoffman CA Fabrics **WAVE** fabric,
one **LINING FABRIC** and one **COORDINATING FABRIC**

FOCUS FABRIC (must have 42" of useable width)

Sides and Rim Outside 1½ yards

LINING FABRIC (non-directional)

Sides and Rim Inside 1½ yards

COORDINATING FABRIC

Binding, Top, Bottom 3¼ yards

INTERFACING

Bosal's **CRAF-TEX PLUS** (#337F-20) double-sided fusible stiff interfacing (20" wide)

Bottoms (SET of THREE -3½ yards) ¾ yard 1¼ yards 1½ yards

Note: If making the large oval you can also use Bosal's die cut bottom #CABL (2 pkgs)

IN-R-FORM PLUS by Bosal a double-sided fusible foam batting 58" wide

Sides, Rim (SET of THREE -3½ yards) 1 yard 1⅞ yards 1¼ yards

Other Tools: Matching thread - we like So Fine by Superior. Buttons for embellishments. Also, for hand sewing, use a heavy cotton thread like Aurifil's 12 weight cotton. Sewing Machine with free arm. Machine needles - try Janome Purple Tip needles. Parchment paper or Teflon ironing sheet. Iron. Scissors (both large and small), rotary mat, 60mm rotary cutter, acrylic rulers, chalk, seam ripper, measuring tape, pins (flower pins and fine) and hand sewing needles - Milliner's needles size 7. Rubber needle puller.

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
